	charges resuming in Ripon on a pre-paid basis.
	Cllr Martin advised that due to a number of HBC staff having to shield, grass cutting had stopped across the district while staff focused on essential services. Grass cutting is beginning to
	resume.

	consultation on returning the road surfaces to tarmac.
	Glovers Bridge damage is due to be repaired in July 2020.
