21/25	To consider the provision of Ripon to Leeds bus service during bank holidays and to agree appropriate action. It was noted that during bank holidays, particularly on New Year's Day, Ripon residents who do not drive and have no one to give them a lift find themselves cut off from Harrogate, unable to visit their family/friends in hospital or travel to work in Harrogate, as there are no bus running from Ripon to Harrogate. That RCC write a letter to the bus company to investigate what measures could be taken to address this issue. RESOLVED.	
22/25	To consider the installation of the following: 1. Festoon lighting around the Market Square. That RCC purchase new festoon lighting that is fixed to the lamp columns around the square to create lighting but positioned at the top of the lamp posts. This lighting should be kept on all year round and form part of the Christmas lights display.

Cllr Williams advised that Transdev is going to undertake works for improving the general condition of the Ripon bus station in the coming weeks; provided an update on NYC's financial position and advised that the funding for resurfacing of Moss's Arcade and Victoria Grove has been secured, with works due to be undertaken at the beginning of the summer. Both Cllrs Brodigan and Williams noted that there are ongoing discussions with YMCA and North Yorkshire Council about the use of Town Hall. 2.
