	It was then discussed about creating a new community interest organisation and another sole corporate trustee charity where RCC would be the sole corporate trustee in a second charity which would be tied into the creation of a community interest organisation so that Full Council would still retain control of the charitable activities and then hive off commercial activities and daily business to a community interest organisation. The creation of the particular vehicles for this purpose is more appropriate for the turning of the Town Hall into a business and commercial venture was the advise that the Chief Officer received from the solicitors.
